### **"Four Glimpses Into Finding Peace"**

**Glimpse #1:** The (1) \_\_\_\_\_ of a Woman – v. 25-26

**Mark 5:25-26**—"Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse."

Luke 2:14 (NIV)—“Glory to God in the highest,  
and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests.”

Mark 9:50 (NIV)—“Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at **peace** with each other.”

Luke 7:50 (NIV)—“Jesus said to the woman, “Your faith has saved you; go in **peace**.”

Luke 10:5 (NIV)—“When you enter a house, first say, **Peace** to this house.’

Luke 24:36 (NIV)—“While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, “**Peace** be with you.”

John 14:27—“Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”

**QUESTION:** Do you have Peace?

Isaiah 26:3—“You will keep him in perfect peace,

Whose mind is stayed on You,  
Because he trusts in You.”

The Woman’s Life of Misery:

Luke 7:16—“Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, “A great prophet has risen up among us”; and, “God has visited His people.”

Luke 8:39—“Return to your own house, and tell what great things God has done for you.” And he went his way and proclaimed throughout the whole city what great things Jesus had done for him.”

Luke 13:17—“And when He said these things, all His adversaries were put to shame; and all the multitude rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by Him.”

**Glimpse #3:** A (15) \_\_\_\_\_ Performed – v. 29

Mark 5:29—“Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.”

**FACT:** Jesus Christ didn’t (16) \_\_\_\_\_ perform this miracle.
